

## HISTORY: GARDEN CLUB OF NORFOLK

1915	Garden Club of Norfolk organized February 24th at the home of Mrs. Frederic Killam: motto "A garden is a lovesome thing".
1918	Established dogwood as floral emblem of Virginia adopted by legislature March 6, 1918.
1920	Charter member of Garden Club of Virginia, which it helped to organize.
1922	Admitted to membership of The Garden Club of America.
1922	Named crepe myrtle as Norfolk's official flower, adopted by City Council on May 2, 1922.
1923	Saved Westover Oak and created memorial tablet to Dead of World War I. "Grim death has vanished leaving in its stead the shining glory of the living dead".
1924	Sponsored Winchester-Clark Garden Club for Garden Club of Virginia membership.
1926	Participated in Monticello Flower Show sponsored by Garden Club of Virginia to save Monticello trees.
1928	Sponsored the Nansemond River Garden Club for Garden Club of Virginia membership.
1928	Historic Garden Week started in Virginia. Garden Club of Norfolk has participated yearly.
1928-48	Helped establish first wildflower preserve in area in cooperation with Princess Anne Garden Club. Relinquished control to Princess Anne Garden Club in 1948.
1931	Sponsored Williamsburg Garden Club for Garden Club of Virginia membership.
1931	Sponsored Hampton Roads Garden Club for Garden Club of Virginia membership.
1931	Sponsored Princess Anne Garden Club for Garden Club of Virginia membership.
1932	Sponsored Fredericksburg Garden Club for Garden Club of Virginia membership.
1932	Ring of live oaks planted around Hague as memorial to first Garden Club of Norfolk President, Mrs. Frederic Killam.
1933	First Camellia Show held at Norfolk Museum of Arts and Sciences.
1933	Hosted Annual Meeting Garden Club of Virginia.
1933	Mrs. Fergus Reid was awarded the Massie Medal for her work in preserving the Westover Memorial Oak and other beautification projects she had spearheaded.
1941-45	During World War II, promoted victory gardens, sent seeds abroad, and raised funds with a garden party for an ambulance for Great Britain. 100% active in war relief. Planted thousands of roses in Navy Bases.
1946-48	Mrs. C. James Andrews, President of Garden Club of Virginia.
1946	Massie Medal Horticulture honor given to Garden Club of Norfolk for 9 years of successful camellia shows.

Organized Junior Garden Club of Norfolk composed of daughters and

1961	Massie Medal awarded to Mrs. Harvey Lindsay for passage of the Anti-Billboard Bill and for 25 years service dedicated to protection and preservation of natural roadside beauty.
1961	The Colonial Garden created in Norfolk Botanical Garden in memory of our Garden Club of Norfolk founders.
1965	Sponsored 1st Annual Garden Club of Virginia Daffodil Show.
1969	Garden Club of Virginia Annual Meeting in Norfolk.
1971	Began planting perennial and herb garden at Willoughby Baylor House.
1974	deLacy Gray Memorial Medal to Mrs. Mayor F. Fogler for conservation. Described as "dirtgrubbing gardener".
1975	Bicentennial scarf designed by Mrs. Thomas H. Willcox, Jr. and produced by Frankie Welch. It incorporated a blooming American flag in red, blue and white on green.
1976-78	Mrs. Toy D. Savage, Jr. President of Garden Club of Virginia.
1979	deLacy Gray Memorial Medal awarded to Mrs. John E. Clarkson who spearheaded the passionate fight to save Norfolk from the Oil refinery.
1980	Garden Club of Norfolk and Garden Club of Virginia Beach co-hosted Garden Club of America at the Omni Hotel.
1980	Landscape completed on small garden at Children's Hospital of King's Daughters.
1982	\$5,000 given to Bird and Wildlife Preserve of Weyanoke Sanctuary, a unique inner city oasis.
1984	Garden Club of Virginia Rose Show at Norfolk Botanical Gardens.
1985	Restored Hermitage Museum garden. Garden Club of Norfolk continues to refurbish plantings.
1986	Garden Club of Virginia received Garden Club of America medal for Historic Preservation which is awarded for outstanding work in the field of preservation and/or restoration of historic gardens or buildings of national importance. The Garden Club of Norfolk proposed Garden Club of Virginia for this award seconded by Garden Club of Virginia Beach.
1989	1st Annual Tidewater Horticultural Symposium co-sponsored with Garden Club of Virginia Beach.
1989	Restored the Chrysler Museum Memorial Garden, asked members to green the garden with direct contributions of \$10,000.
1990	First Annual Christmas Greenery Sale.
1990	Donated entrance arbor at the Norfolk Botanical Gardens.
