Handley High School, a privately endowed public school and now on the National Register of Historic Places, opened its doors in 1923. The Garden Club restored the original planting scheme at the front of the building and along the west end of the "bowl", where the football field is located. GCV sponsored the design of the landscape park east of the bowl. Construction of new walks in this area is nearing completion. Dozens of trees have been planted, including restoration of the allee of oaks from the bowl to Valley Avenue, a central piece of McCormack's original vision. [Learn more.](#)

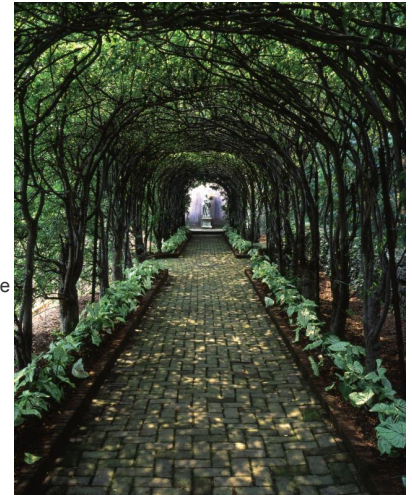
